PROFILE OF PROFESSOR DANLADI I. MUSA



Danladi Ibrahim Musa earned his PhD from Obafemi Awolowo University (OAU), Ife, Nigeria, and his Master's and Bachelor's degrees from Ahmadu Bello University (ABU), Zaria, Nigeria. With over 40 years of teaching experience, Professor Musa has published over 100 scientific and research articles, coauthored books, book chapters, technical reports, and conference papers, and has over 600 citations.

He was the Coordinator of the Human Performance laboratory in the Department of Human Kinetics and Health Education at Prince Abubakar Audu University, Nigeria. Over the years, he has held key academic and

administrative positions, including Dean of the Faculty of Education, Dean School of Postgraduate Studies, Director of Research and Innovation, and Director of Quality Assurance at the University.

A significant milestone in Professor Musa's career was the receipt of two distinguished academic fellowships: the World Bank Junior Fellowship at Louisiana State University, USA (nine months) in 1994 and the prestigious Commonwealth Academic Staff Fellowship at the University of Exeter, UK (six months), where he conducted postdoctoral research from 2010 to 2011 alongside global leaders in Physical Activity and Pediatric Health.

Throughout his career, he has supervised 40 postgraduate students to the successful completion of their Ph.D. and Master's degrees. Additionally, he has served as an external examiner for over a hundred doctoral and master's theses both nationally and internationally. Professor Musa has participated in 35 conferences and workshops across various countries, including the United Kingdom, the United States, the United Arab Emirates, South Africa, and Kenya.

Professor Musa serves on the editorial boards of several esteemed journals, including the Multidisciplinary Science Journal (MSJ) (Brazil). He is also a Guest Editor for the Open Public Health Journal (OPHJ) (United Arab Emirates) and a Review Editor for *Frontiers in Physiology* (Switzerland). Additionally, he is an active member of various professional associations such as the International Society for the Advancement of Kinanthropometry (ISAK), the American College of Sports Medicine (ACSM), the British Association of Sports and Exercise Science (BASES), the Nigerian Association for Physical Education, Recreation, Sports and Dance (NAPHER.SD), the Nigerian Association of Sports Science and Medicine (NASSM), and the Health Promotion Research Association of Nigeria (HEPRAN). His research interests focus on physical activity and pediatric health.

Professor Musa enjoys music, jogging and playing badminton in his leisure time. He is happily married with children.



GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS

Manuscript Types

The journal publishes the following types of papers:

- a. Original Articles
- b. Review Articles
- c. Case Reports
- d. Short communications

Manuscript structure

Manuscripts should be prepared using a word-processing package and save in .doc or .docx format. The font type and font size should preferably be Times New Roman 12 points. The manuscript should be double-spaced and should include page numbers. The manuscript should include the below items and organized in the following order:

- 1. Cover letter
- 2. Title page
- 3. Abstract and 4-6 Key words
- 4. Main Body: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusion, Funding (if any), Conflict of interest.
- 5. Figures and tables (should be reported in latest APA format).
- 6. References

Contributors

Each author is required to declare their individual contribution to the article: all authors must have materially participated in the research and/or article preparation, not merely questionnaire distribution or proofreading services, so all authors should be described. All author contributions must be disclosed.

Changes to authorship

The author(s) list and order of authors must be verified before submitting manuscript. Changes to the list must be directed to the Editor-in-Chief via mail. To request a change, the following must be sent in the mail through the corresponding author: the reason for the change in author list and written signed (e-mail, letter) from all authors agreeing to such changes. After the manuscript has been accepted, it is only on cogent request(s) changes would be accepted.

All correspondence, including notification of the Editor's decision and requests for revision, is sent by e-mail.

Multi-part papers from the same author(s) will not to be considered. Papers that are requested by the editors to be revised must be returned within 4 weeks or they will be regarded as withdrawn.





Peer Review Policy

This journal uses a double anonymized review, which means all identities of the authors are concealed from the reviewers, and vice versa. The author details will be requested on the final manuscript submitted after review. All submissions will be initially assessed by the editor for suitability for the journal. Suitable papers are then sent to a minimum of two independent expert reviewers to assess the quality of the paper. The reviewer's reports are reviewed and a decision is reached by the editor. The Editor's decision is final. However, editorial board members are not involved in decisions about papers which they have written, co-authored, written by their colleagues or others which are thought to relate to the integrity of the review process.

Reviewer's report would be in the following form:

- i. Publishable with minor corrections
- ii. Publishable after major corrections: This work will go through the review process when resubmitted but will be sent to only one reviewer.
- iii. Not publishable: Works marked like this, might be restructured and may be submitted back to the journal as a new manuscript.

Note: For anonymized manuscript(s), the following guide should be adhered;

Title page (with author details): This should include the title, authors' names, affiliations, funding details (if any), any conflicting interest(s), and the postal address for the corresponding author including an e-mail address.

Anonymized manuscript (no author details): The main body of the paper (including the references, figures, tables and any acknowledgements) should not include any identifying information, such as the authors' names or affiliations.

Publication Charge

Publication fee for manuscripts in this journal is twenty-five thousand naira only (local authors) or forty dollars (\$40) this also covers shipment fee, for foreign subscribers.

Vetting fee/ Publication fee

The non-refundable sum of five thousand naira (N5,000) is paid while submitting for the first time, and a publication fee of (N25,000) is paid only after manuscripts have been accepted by the editor for publishing.
